their objections with the Commission, they shall send a copy of their objections to the AEQUS directly, to enable the AEQUS to send replies to them under intimation to the Commission. The last date for receipt of objections from the public may be indicated **as 30 days from the date of publication of the petition in the newspaper.** The replies by the AEQUS, to the written objections, may be furnished to the objectors within a week's time positively, duly forwarding a copy of the said replies to the Commission.

The copies of the Tariff Petition along with the relevant documents shall be kept ready on the date of publication of petition itself and made available to the interested persons on demand. The AEQUS shall also host the Tariff Petition, along with the Commission's preliminary observations and AEQUS's replies thereon, on its website.

You are directed to submit the copies of the summary of the petition, published in the newspaper, to the Commission, for information and record.
